Highlights of Retail Supply Tariff Order issued on 17th December 2020

1. The DISCOMs have projected Annual Revenue Requirement (ARR) of Rs. 40,016 Crore for FY 2020-21, with a revenue gap of Rs. 2,169 Crore at existing tariff and proposed to recover this gap through a tariff hike of 5.73% on existing tariffs.
2. The Commission has allowed ARR of Rs. 37,673 Crore for FY 2020-21, with a revenue gap of Rs. 730 Core at existing tariff. The Commission has allowed a tariff hike of only 1.98% across the categories to recover this gap.
3. No tariff hike for following categories:
 - a. Domestic consumers having load up to 100 watt with monthly consumptions up to 30 units
 - b. LT Industries
 - c. Temporary connections for social/marriage purposes and religious functions
 - d. E -Vehicles / E -Rikshaw Charging stations
 - e. Railway Traction
4. No metering charges are allowed, hence consumers will not be required to pay meter rent.
5. Tariff for temporary connection for construction of own house has been reduced and period has been extended from maximum 1 year to 3 years.
6. The Commission has rationalised the tariff for HV 5 category by merging HV 5.1: Public Water Works, Group Irrigation and Lift Irrigation Schemes with HV 5.2: Other than agricultural use.
7. Agriculture – Taking into account subsidy given by the State Government for agriculture category, consumers having load up to 10 HP shall be billed at the rate of Rs. 750 per HP per annum. The consumers above 10 HP shall be billed at the rate of Rs. 1500 per HP per annum.

Existing Rebates retained by the Commission in this order

1. Rebates / Incentives for pre-paid metering, advance bill payments, prompt bill payments, online bill payments shall be continued without any change.
2. Rebate / Incentives allowed on Time Of Day (TOD) tariff, Load Factor & Power Factor shall be continued without any change.
3. Rebate / Incentives applicable for new and existing HT/EHT connections, captive power plants, Railway Traction and Open Access Consumers shall be continued without any change.
